LET'S START WRITING!



IN FEW WORDS...

- I learned this technique in an outstanding seminar some years ago. That is why, I would like to share my experience writing in a second language.
- It has helped me a great deal since I have been able to write short stories in English for my son and my students from Liceo Agrícola de Chillán.
- I kindly invite you to follow these six steps.



STEP 1

KEYWORD: **THINK**



- WRITE YOUR IDEAS
- TAKE A SEAT AND FEEL READY
- LISTEN TO RELAXING MUSIC
- REFLECT ON: WHAT AM I GOING TO WRITE ABOUT?



STEP 2

KEYWORD: **DECISION**



- HOW LONG IS YOUR WRITING GOING TO BE?
- PARAGRAPHS?
- NUMBER OF WORDS?



• IS IT FOR FUN?



• IS IT FOR ACADEMIA?

STEP 3

KEYWORD: **WRITE**



- LET'S GET STARTED!
- **LET IT FLOW.**
- **YOUR HAND, YOUR PENCIL, YOUR MIND.**
- **DO NOT PAY ATTENTION TO PUNCTUATION YET.**
- **FEEL FREE!!!**



STEP 4

KEYWORD: **READ**



- AFTER WRITING, MAKE A CUP OF COFFEE/TEA...



- **STAND UP AND BREATHE.**

- **READ YOUR COMPOSITION.**

- **REFLECT ON WHAT YOU JUST WROTE.**

- DO YOU LIKE IT?

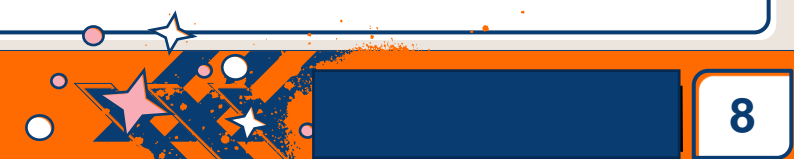
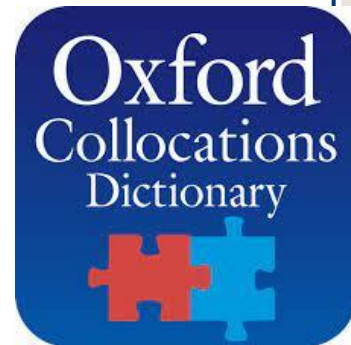


STEP 5

KEYWORD: **EDITION**



- MAKE CHANGES TO YOUR COMPOSITION.
- PAY ATTENTION TO GRAMMAR AND PUNCTUATION.
- MY RECOMMENDATION IS TO USE A COLLOCATIONS DICTIONARY IN THIS PART.
- **HAVE SOMEBODY ELSE READ YOUR WORK.**



STEP 6

KEYWORD: **PUBLISH**



- DELIVER YOUR WORK.
- **FEEL GREAT WITH YOURSELF.**
- DO NOTHING NOW... TAKE A BREAK!
